PROJECT GOAL

TO IMPROVE THE STATE OF HEALTH OF THE PILOT DISTRICT POPULATION, ESPECIALLY THAT OF CHILDREN AND WOMEN BY WAY OF ENHANCING THE ACCESSIBILITY AND QUALITY OF PRIMARY HEALTH CARE, AND THE EFFICIENCY OF RESOURCE UTILISATION IN THE HEALTH CARE SYSTEM



PROJECT OBJECTIVES (1)

TO INCREASE THE ACCESSIBILITY, EFFICACY AND QUALITY OF HEALTH SERVICES IN THE PRIMARY HEALTH CARE SECTOR BY MEANS OF:

- **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BASIC PACKAGE OF SERVICES**
- **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ESSENTIAL DRUGS POLICY**
- **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STANDARD HEALTH CARE, TREATMENT AND PROTOCOLS**
- **DEVELOPMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES**



PROJECT OBJECTIVES (2)

TO INCREASE THE EFFICACY AND EFFICIENCY OF HEALTH SERVICES BY MEANS OF:

- **RATIONALISATION THE STRUCTURE OF PRIMARY HEALTH CARE (PHC)**
- **STRENGTHENING THE PHC MANAGEMENT**
- **STREAMLINING THE FUNDING SYSTEM OF HEALTH SERVICES**

- **INVOLVING COMMUNITIES IN THE PROCESS OF HEALTH SERVICES PLANNING, ORGANISATION AND EVALUATION**

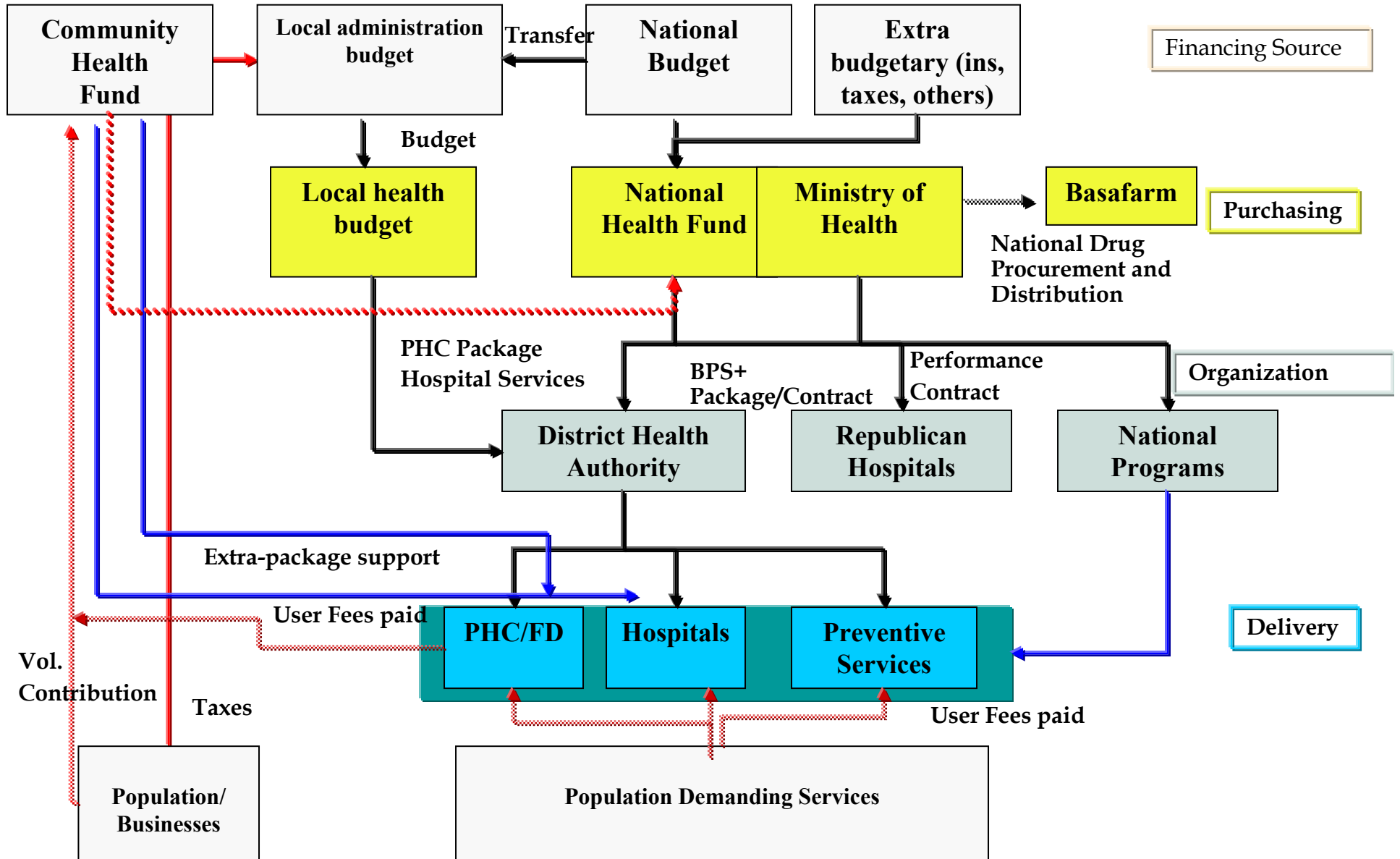

PROJECT ACHIEVEMENTS

- **THE BASIC PACKAGE OF SERVICES WAS ELABORATED**
- **THE ESSENTIAL DRUGS POLICY WERE IMPLEMENTED**
- **A NOVEL STRUCTURE WAS ESTABLISHED IN ORDER TO STRENGTHEN MANAGEMENT, FINANCING, ORGANISATION OF PROCUREMENT, STORAGE AND DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS FOR ESSENTIAL DRUGS**



PROJECT ACHIEVEMENTS

- **THE TRAINING FOR LOCAL PHYSICIANS WAS CONDUCTED**
- **INFORMATION, EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION MODELS IN COMMUNITIES WERE DEVELOPED AND THE “CHANGE DRIVERS” FOR THE SOCIAL MOBILISATION OF THE POPULATION WERE TRAINED**



PROJECT RESULTS

- **TOTAL VISITS TO GPS HAVE BEEN INCREASED BY 12%**
- **EXPENDITURE IN PHC HAS INCREASED BY 43%**
- **TRAINING IN THE USE OF PROTOCOLS IN 75% OF ALL GPS**
- **TRAINING COVERED OVER 90% OF THE MANAGEMENT STAFF**
- **THE PROJECT PROVIDES ACCESS TO 109 DRUGS THAT ARE DIRECTLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE TREATMENT PROTOCOLS**
